May 25, 2021

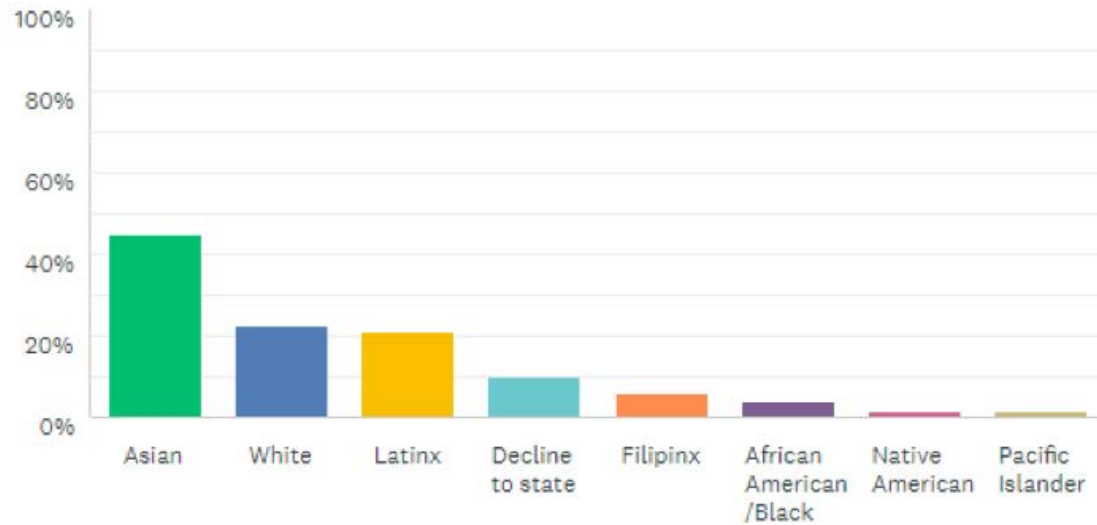
Survey Administration

- Sent to 15,522 students with a valid email address
- Administered May 19-24, via initial and reminder emails, personalized by students' first names
- Approximately 3-minute survey; branched by response

3,942 responses for a 25% response rate

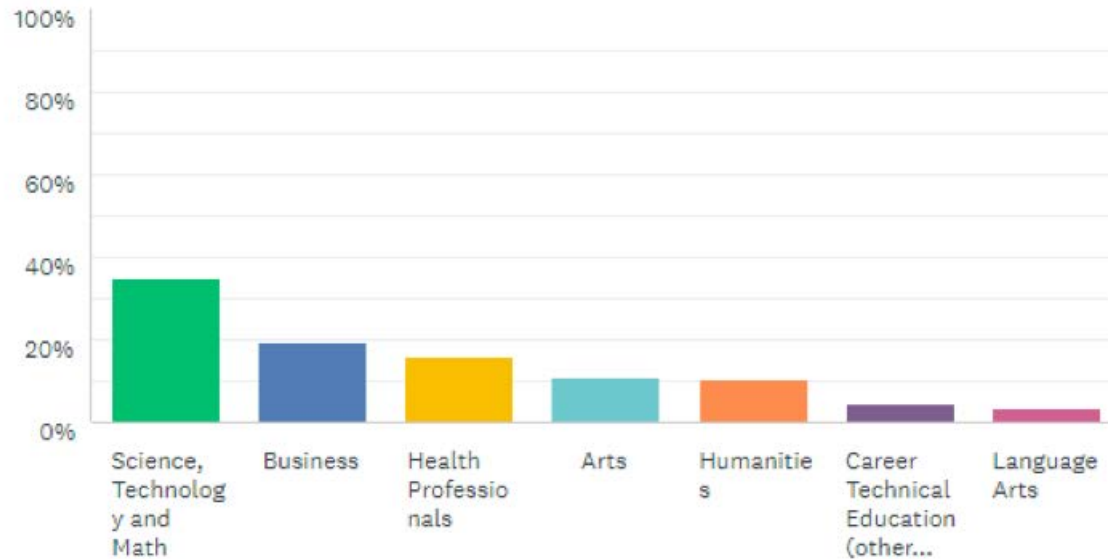

Which department most closely aligns with your major?

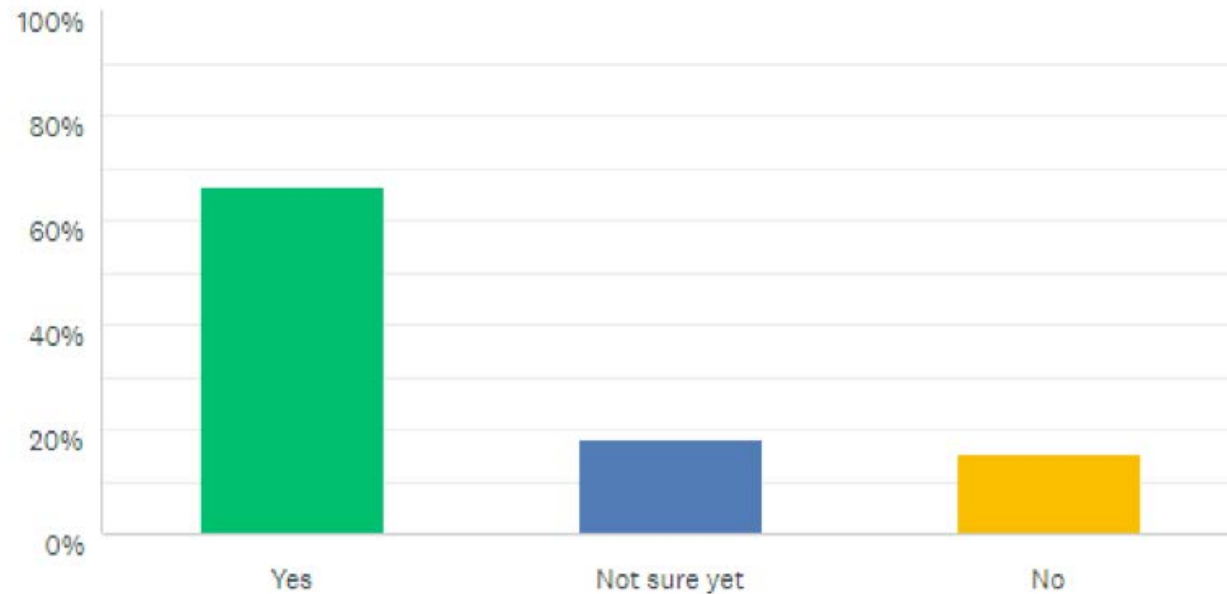

Do you plan to return in fall quarter?

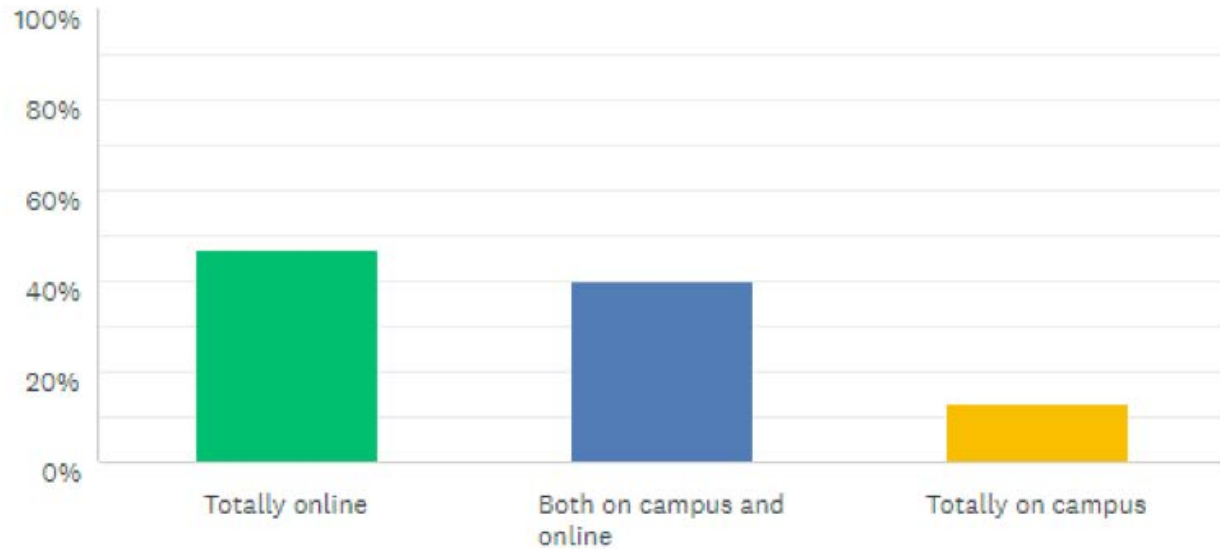

How would you prefer to take classes in the fall?

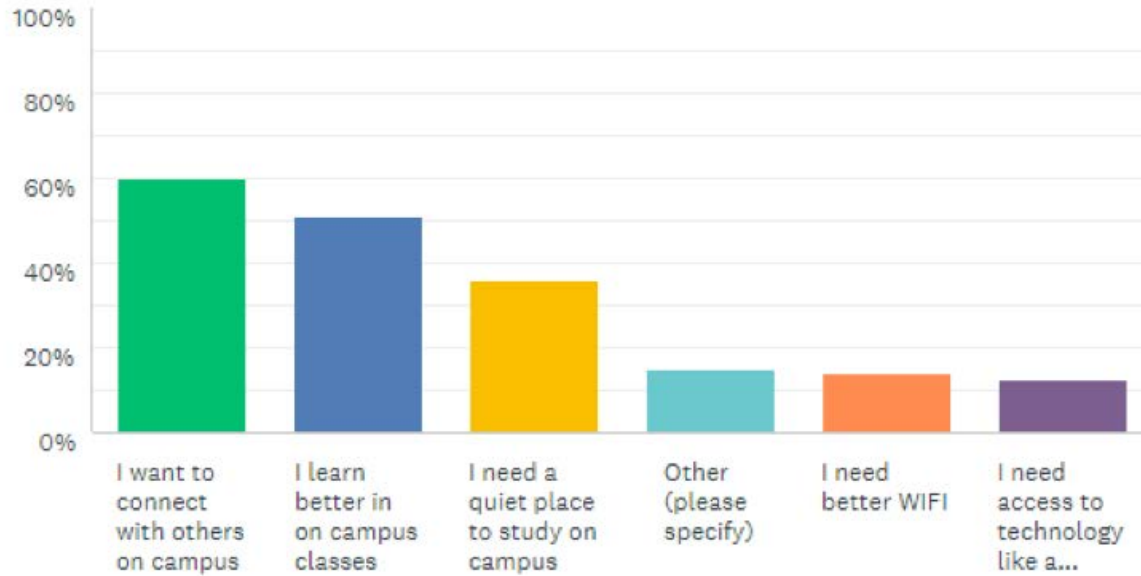

What factors would influence whether you would want to take on-campus classes?

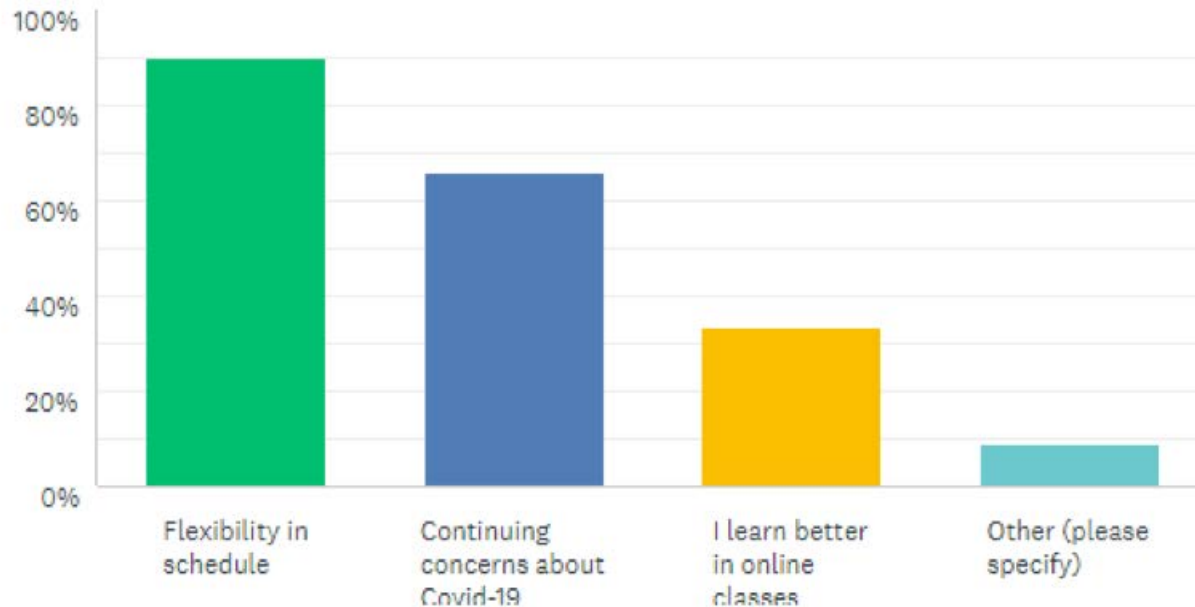

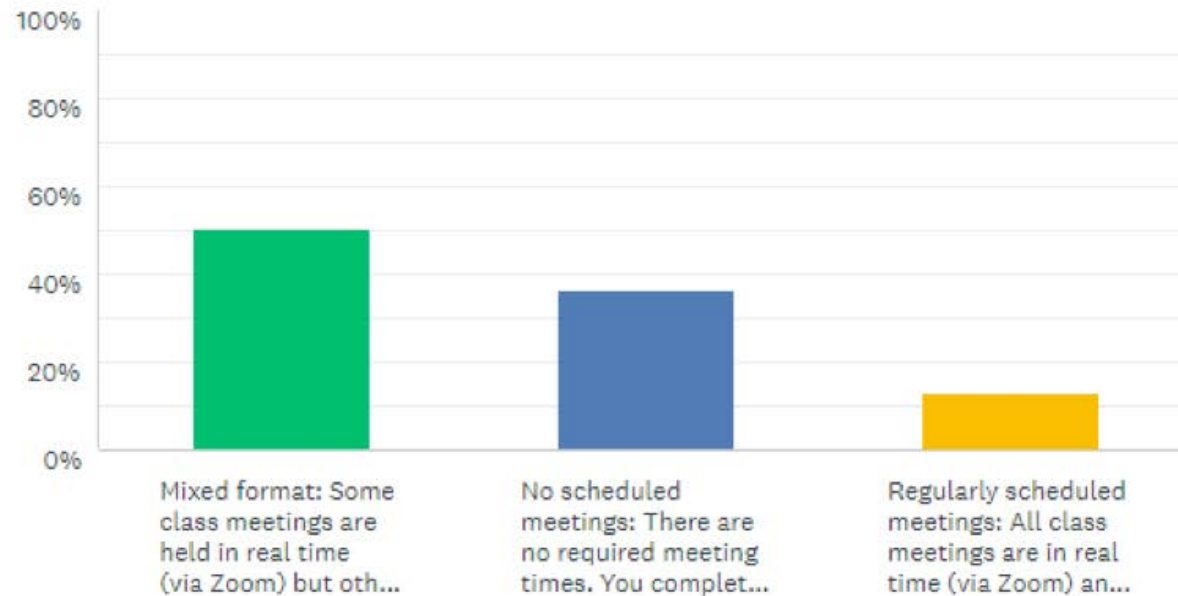

▼ No scheduled meetings: There are no required meeting times. You complete the coursework at your own pace within the scheduled due dates.	37%	1,169
▼ Regularly scheduled meetings: All class meetings are in real time (via Zoom) and you are required to attend at the scheduled time.	13%	410

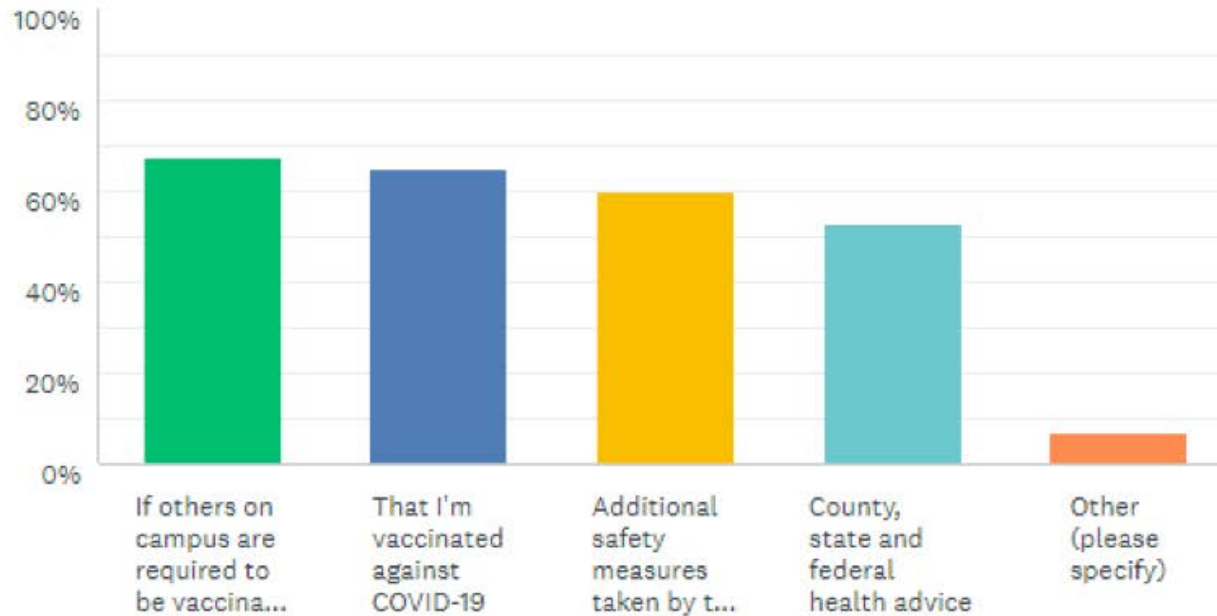

What factors involving COVID-19 would influence whether you would want to attend classes on campus in the fall?



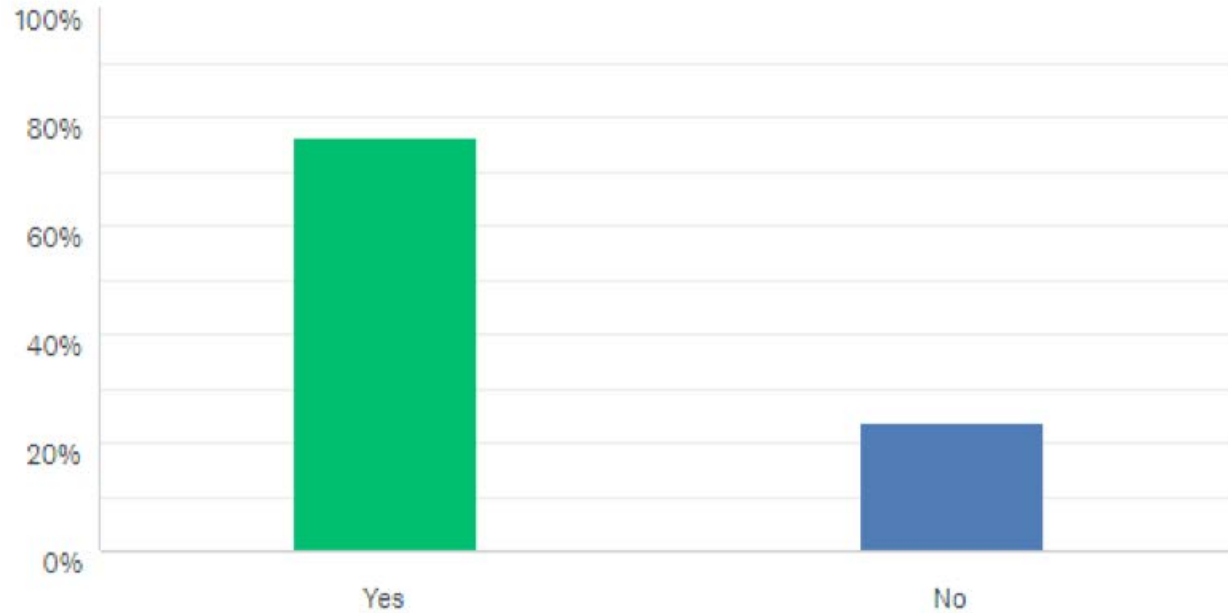

Have you already been vaccinated against COVID-19?

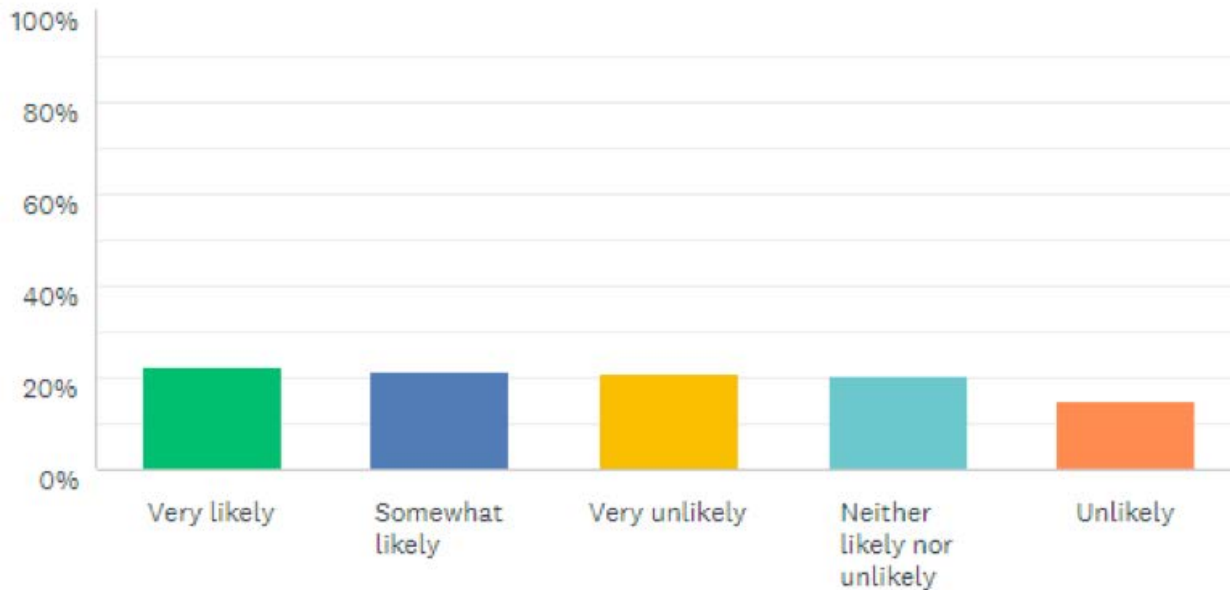

- **June 24** – Second reading of draft policy by email with Chancellor's Advisory Council
- **July 12** – Draft board policy presented to Board of Trustees

Preparing to Return – Departmental Process

- COVID-19 Protection and Prevention Plan
- County Social Distancing protocol (SDP)
- Potential exposure incident procedure and policy
- Tracking close contacts
- Signs and flags for ingress and egress pathways from parking lots
- Post SDP and place tape/stickers on floor
- Policy for screening and responsibilities for students while on campus
- Canvas Assignments for faculty and students
- Student and faculty PPE supplies
- Measuring classroom to allow for social distancing
- Plexiglass barriers/dividers for clinic
- Types of air filtration units for all rooms
- Hypochlorous acid fogger and solution
- Respiratory Protection Plan (N95)

What will you do if a...

- Student doesn't want to wear a mask or has a medical clearance to not wear a mask or face covering?
- Faculty member tests COVID positive?
- Student tests COVID positive?
- Member of the student's household was exposed to someone with COVID?
- Member of the student's household is COVID positive?
- Student texts faculty "I have symptom(s)"?
- Faculty has to self-isolate from possible exposure?

The Dental Hygiene Experience

What will you do if...

- Santa Clara County guidelines conflict with other regulatory agencies?
- It's a hot day and a student's temperature is over 100?
- Students notify you they are carpooling together?
- It is reported to you or you observe that your students were congregating together on campus without masks?
- Your student has symptoms within 48 hours of your lab session?
- A student needs one or more make-up labs due to mid-quarter self-isolation?

What we experienced:

- Extra time needed to clear students before coming to campus AND when they arrive to campus. (survey, temp screening, etc.)
- Make schedules but have Plan B, C and D
 - Accept your schedule will probably change mid-quarter
- Difficult to be understood and to hear students with PPE
- Zoom meetings either weekly or before each lab is helpful
- Not all students comply at same level
- How will big holidays for example Halloween, Thanksgiving come into play with students' compliance
- Keeping in touch with Zoom tutors and requiring students to meet with the tutors via breakout room are helpful
